

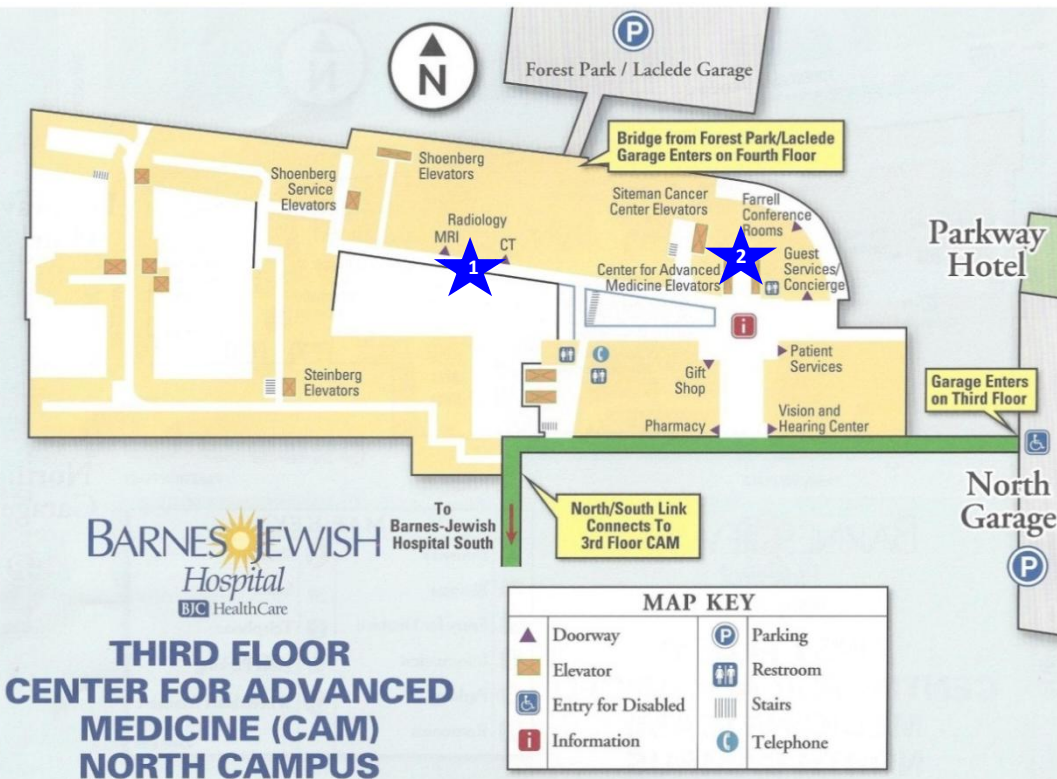

Directions for Patients with Radiology Appointments on the

## North Campus of Barnes-Jewish Hospital in the Center for Advanced Medicine (CAM)

If you are using a Navigation System enter  
224 South Euclid Ave,  
St. Louis, MO 63110  
to take you to the North Garage.

*\*Please note handicap parking is available in the garage. Wheel chairs are located near the garage elevators. Also, valet parking is available for an additional \$2.00 charge and free of charge with a handicap sticker. If you choose to valet, please stop at the information desk for directions. The directions below are only from the self park garage not from valet.*

### Step-by-Step Directions from the North Garage

- Once you park in the North Garage take the garage elevators to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Cross the bridge into the CAM building.
- Take the 1<sup>st</sup> right and continue towards the information desk (i).
- Depending on the type of appointment, follow star 1 or star 2 below and also on the map to the left.

### **1** For patients going to CT, Interventional Radiology (IR), Neuroradiology, or MRI

- Turn left just past the information desk and proceed down the hallway.
  - **CT, Interventional Radiology (IR) & Neuroradiology patients** - 1<sup>st</sup> waiting room on the right.
  - **MRI patients** - 2<sup>nd</sup> waiting room on the right.

### **2** For patients going to Nuclear Medicine, PET, Diagnostic (X-ray), Ultrasound, GI/GU, or Bone Density

- Take the CAM elevators in front of the information desk (i) down to the 2<sup>nd</sup> level.
- Once on the 2<sup>nd</sup> level go to the end of the hall and enter the glass doors on the right into Radiology.
- Inside if you are a **Nuclear Medicine or PET patient** check in on the right. If you are a **Diagnostic (X-ray), Ultrasound, GI/GU, or Bone Density patient** turn left down the hallway and check in will be half way down the hall on the left.
